

# Accelerated Dual Degree PARTNERSHIP IN Nursing Course Curriculum

The A-DDPN is ideal for students who have a non-nursing bachelor's degree or higher and want a fast-track path to the nursing profession. The program is an intense, full-time, immersion experience that spans 18 months, after which students will earn both an associate's degree and a bachelor of science degree with a major in nursing and be prepared to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX).
