## College Receives \$1 Million Gift from Eagan Estate

St. Joseph's College of Nursing recently announced receipt of a \$1 million gift from the estate of Josephine Mastrangelo Eagan, '54. The unrestricted gift represents the largest gift ever received by the College of Nursing and the largest gift given from Eagan's estate.

Born in Rome, NY, Eagan received a bachelor of arts degree from Boston College after graduating from St. Joseph's. She then practiced nursing in California before marrying and moving to Detroit, where she lived for the remainder of her life.

"The College of Nursing is extremely grateful that Mrs. Eagan chose to bestow such a wonderful gift to her alma mater. Her kindness will live on in future generations of nurses graduating from St. Joseph's," said Marianne Markowitz, dean. "This \$1 million gift will enable St. Joseph's College of Nursing to build upon its already competitive and innovative nursing programs and counteract the severe nursing shortage that is predicted over the next decade. We are honored and thankful for such generosity."

## Grads Serve with U.S. Forces in Afghanistan

In her role, she helped provide medical planning, capabilities and skills that significantly enhanced and supported the medical health and readiness and critical lifesaving skills provided to U.S. force, coalition partners and Afghanistan nationals.

She also helped provide health sector development for the Afghan population, which positively impacted the lives of the citizens and helped develop self-sufficiency and stability in the government of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan. Levy was awarded the Defense Meritorious Service and Joint Service Achievement Medals during the combat tour.

While serving in Afghanistan, Kimberly Lagoe sent the College of Nursing an American flag that was part of a bombing mission to the College of Nursing. The flag and a certificate are on display at the college. Here are some excerpts from an email Lagoe sent recently:

*I'm so glad you received the flag. That flag was actually flown in an F-16 during a combat mission over Afghanistan. The Air Force here provides CAS (combat air support) to Army troops out on the ground. They call in for air support when they get into a situation where they are under heavy fire. Our aircraft can be there at a moment's notice. Unfortunately there are still lives lost here every day. If you ever need a reality check all you have to do is go to a fallen comrade ceremony — really puts life into perspective. Many of them are just kids. I have the opportunity to interact with the locals a little, and they are truly grateful for us. It's amazing when they share their stories.*

*I've had a lot of support from home in donating items. I've been collecting and distributing children's clothing and*

*toys at the field hospital. It's probably the most rewarding thing I've done here. I've been so touched at everyone's response to my request for items. I've been inundated with toys, coloring books, hats, socks, shoes. These are the basic things that I discovered on my first visit that they don't have.*

*There is a mother and child I've been seeing a few weeks in a row and this baby boy can't weigh more than 5 lbs. Looks like a baby that should be in the NICU to me. I was happy to bring him a warm fleece outfit, socks, hat and a blanket last week. He had nothing. It's getting very cold here. The snow is creeping down the mountains, and these people are exposed to the elements. Makes me appreciate and stop complaining about the plywood hut I live in. It's more than they have. Some days, like during yesterday's sand storm, it's hard to understand why people have been fighting over this country for so many years. It's a dust ball, and the people who live here face such obstacles just to survive this harsh land.*

*However, this morning the sun is rising over the mountains, the air is clear and it's absolutely beautiful. Hope everyone is well. I'm about a month and half away from coming home. Thanks for the kind thoughts and prayers.*

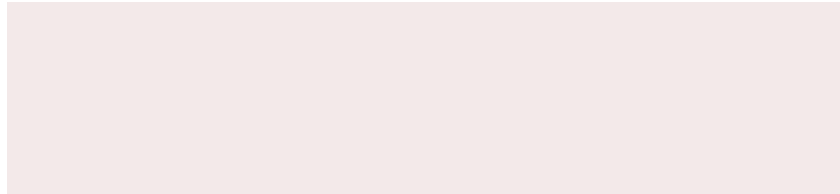
