

Accelerated Dual Degree PARTNERSHIP IN Nursing Course Curriculum

The A-DDPN is ideal for students who have a non-nursing bachelor's degree or higher and want a fast-track path to the nursing profession. The program is an intense, full-time, immersion experience that spans 18 months, after which students will earn both an associated degree and a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in nursing and be prepared to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-RN).
