If you already have an associate's and/or bachelor's degree, you are still required to answer as follows: #29: What will your college grade level be when you begin the school year? Answer: Attended College Before/1st Yr. (unless you are coming directly from high school – Never Attended/1st Yr.). #30: What degree or certificate will you be working on when you begin the school? Answer: Associate's Degree (occupational or technical program) * Federal Direct Loans are awarded at freshman/sophomore loan limits only while in attendance at SJCON as we are an associate level program*
