## **SJCON: GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

### **PURPOSE:**

To provide graduation criteria.

A student will receive the Associate in Applied Science (AAS) with a major in Nursing when the student has:


- completed a minimum of 41 nursing credits at St. Joseph's College of Nursing; 27 Arts and Science credits; for a cumulative totaling of 68.
- completed the educational program with a minimum cumulative grade point average of **78% (C+)**
- been recommended for graduation by the faculty and the Governing Board

Prior to graduation students are requested to:

- complete student loan exit counseling
- return all borrowed library materials
- attend an NCLEX review course
- complete exit interview with Academic Dean
- return identification badge
- complete all evaluations

Formal commencement ceremonies are held at the completion of both weekday and evening/weekend options.
